Subject: Urgent – Kanata Golf Club Lands Request for Action

Dear Premier Ford,

We are writing again on behalf of thousands of concerned residents in Kanata North, as repeated outreach has yet to result in clear direction or action on the Kanata Golf Course (KGC) lands.

At this point, it is deeply frustrating for residents to watch responsibility appear to shift between the Province and the City while significant changes occur on the ground. This issue cannot continue to be treated as a jurisdictional grey area. The risks and impacts to our established community are real, and they are happening now.

You indicated to residents that you would speak with Mayor Mark Sutcliffe. We are asking: **what has come of that conversation?** What direction, if any, has been provided to ensure that community concerns are being addressed?

Given the unresolved environmental, infrastructure, and safety concerns, **we are calling on your government to issue a Ministerial Zoning Order to stop this development immediately.** Residents deserve the assurance that no further irreversible changes will occur.

Site work, including trenching, movement of large volumes of material, and significant alteration of the landscape are destroying a master-planned community.

Residents are increasingly concerned about:

- changes to drainage patterns and stormwater function
- potential environmental impacts associated with soil disturbance, due to proven contamination
- safety and quality-of-life impacts

We have included new video that documents the current conditions on the site, including the scale of earthworks and disruption. It provides a clear, unfiltered view of what is taking place and why residents are alarmed. You can see how water is pooling in areas where soil has been disturbed, and trenches have been cut to move water from flooded areas to larger ponds.

Premier Ford, this is not simply a planning matter – it is a question of public confidence, environmental stewardship, and the protection of existing communities.

Residents are asking for accountability and leadership. We urge you to act.
